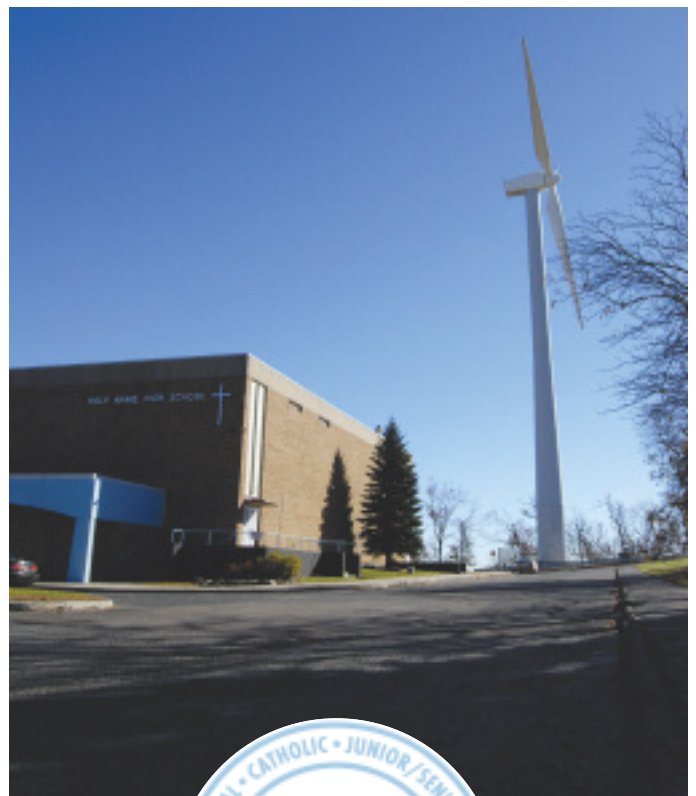

Ronald Fortin

Ronald Fortin, a 1957 Holy Name graduate was named to the T&G All-City and Central Catholic schools All-Star team. He was the first Holy Name basketball player to be chosen for the T&G All-Star Team.

After graduation, Ron began his thirty-five year career with the former Worcester County Institution for Savings. While at WCIS, he attended Clark University and Assumption College and graduated from American Institute of Banking and the School for Supervisory Personnel.

During a tour of duty in Germany with the Air Force, Ron played basketball in the Armed Forces League and was named to the southern Germany All-Star team.

In the 60's Ron founded a folk group called The Fresh Lads and performed at local coffee houses, clubs and colleges.

Since retiring from the bank in 1994 as Senior Vice President, Ron and his wife Ginny, enjoy spending time with their three daughters and two grandsons.



Margaret McKenna Mangaudis

During her high school years, Margaret McKenna Mangaudis participated in the annual musical, was president of the Student Council, honor roll student all four years, member of the tennis team, Blood Drive Chairman, and member of the National Honor Society.

After earning her B.A. in Business Management from Emmanuel College she later returned to school to earn her MBA from Boston University.

In 1987 Margaret became Vice President of Human Resources of St. Vincent Healthcare System, Inc. where she was responsible for the entire Human Resources function. The Healthcare system included a teaching hospital, three nursing homes, clinical laboratory company and a physician-hospital organization. Amy O'Brien Davagian

A graduate of the class of 1995, Amy O'Brien Davagian was a member of the student council, an honor roll student throughout her four years at Holy Name and an outstanding basketball player. Amy is the all time scoring leader in girls' basketball at Holy Name. She also led the Naps to their first district title in girl's basketball in 1994.

Amy, a graduate of the College of the Holy Cross, was an outstanding basketball player there as well. As senior captain, she was unanimously selected as the Patriot League Scholar Athlete of the Year. She was just the second women's player in the school's history to top the 2,000 point mark and the only one to score more than 2,000 points in Division I. She won the prestigious Crusader of the Year award in 1999 and was also named Player of the Year. She is in the Holy Cross Hall of Fame and in the New England Basketball Hall of Fame.

Currently, Amy is a high school and college basketball referee. She and husband, John, are the parents of 5 year old Kathryn and 3 year old Alison.

Hall of Fame Nomination Information

Dear Fellow Alumni/ae:

The Holy Name Central Catholic Junior/Senior High School Hall of Fame was established in 2002 to honor Alumni and others associated with Holy Name whose outstanding accomplishments and other contributions serve as motivational examples to current students and the entire Holy Name community. A listing of past inductees is included in the newsletter.

The Hall of Fame Selection Committee is seeking nominations for induction into the Hall of Fame in September, 2011. The following are criteria for eligibility

- A candidate must be a graduate of Holy Name Central Catholic Senior High School and must have graduated no less than 10 years prior to the year of induction to the H.O.F. Under special circumstances, the Selection Committee may consider faculty, administration or others associated with Holy Name for election to the Hall of Fame.
- Eligible nominees must be of character that represents and upholds the Catholic ideals, values and mission of Holy Name.
- Consideration for election to the Hall of Fame shall be based on one or more of the following accomplishments:
 1. Distinguished service for Holy Name: The individual has acted in a major leadership role in service to Holy Name through school events, alumni events, fundraising efforts or other significant activity to the benefit of Holy Name.
 2. Service to one's community through volunteer work. Length and quality of volunteer service as well as reputation within the community shall be considered.
 3. Distinguished professional achievement: Individual has attained significant career achievement and highly regarded in his/her profession. Such profession must be aligned with the Catholic ideals, values and mission of Holy Name.

The Hall of Fame Selection Committee looks forward to sharing the great accomplishments of Alumni with the Holy Name community. Please take pride in your school and submit nominations today! The deadline for submittal of nominations is January 14, 2011.

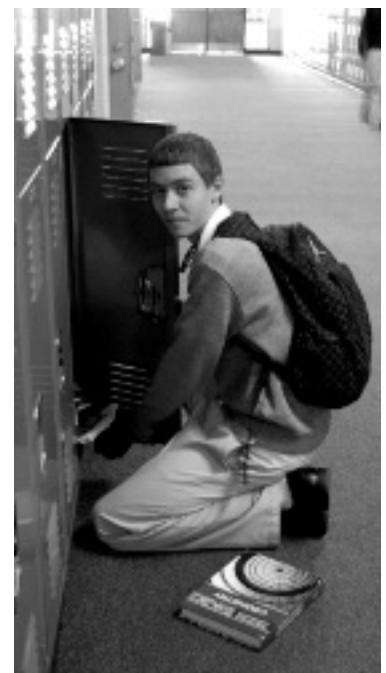

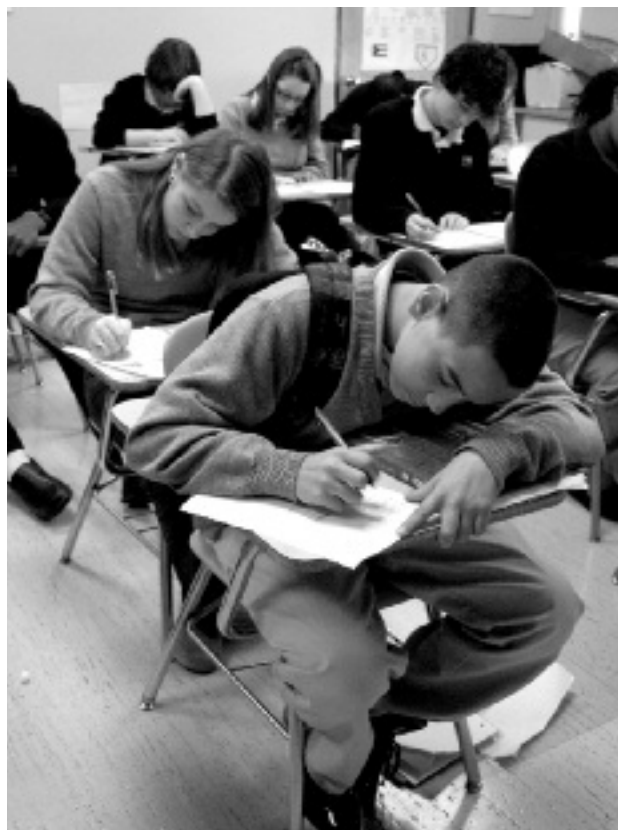
