Our two hundred and sixty-two foot tall 600 kilowatt wind turbine towers over the campus and is visible from many areas in Worcester. The first of its kind in Central Massachusetts, the turbine not only provides all of our school's energy needs in a clean and renewable fashion, it stands as a testament to Holy Name's commitment to leadership in the fast paced and evolving world of environmental and educational technologies.

# New Principal Dr. Bernard Audette



Now a Worcester resident, Holy Name’s new Principal grew up in the Quabbin area of Massachusetts and graduated from Quabbin Regional High School. Dr. Audette received his degree in Political Science from the University of Massachusetts in Amherst and spent the next 12 years in corporate finance managing corporate cash and investments.

Dr. Audette knew in his heart that teaching was his passion. “I am first and foremost a teacher,” he said in a recent interview for this publication. “But we are all teachers. Every interaction with students is a teaching moment,” he added.

After losing a brother to injuries sustained in an automobile accident followed by the joy of the birth of his daughter Megan, Dr. Audette felt it was time to reassess his career path. His wife of 23 years, Emily, told him that he always did want to teach and that maybe the time had come to pursue that dream. He prayed about it, and it became clear that “this is what I’m supposed to do.”

Dr. Audette resumed his studies and received an Ed.S and later his Ed.D in Curriculum and Instruction from Argosy University in Sarasota, FL.

After moving to Hardwick, MA, to be close to family, Dr. Audette began teaching at Quabbin Regional Middle School as a social studies teacher. Soon, he was appointed Principal at Quabbin Regional High School.

When it came time to look at high schools for Megan, the Audette’s looked at Catholic Schools in our Worcester Diocese. “Holy Name was a slam dunk for us,” Dr Audette stated. “So many things are done right here.”

Dr. Audette talked about the importance of the gospel-value centered education here and pointed out that the respect that students and teachers have for one another makes this school a truly remarkable and supportive learning environment. Most importantly, he noted that he and his wife knew Holy Name was the right choice for Megan because almost everyday she would thank them for sending her to Holy Name.

When Dr. Audette saw the Principal position was open at Holy Name, through prayer he became to feel strongly it would be the right place for him as well. Since being hired, he has been enjoying his days “on the hill.” He summed this up by saying, “I am blessed that I can come to school and be part of the Holy Name Mission.” The Audette’s son, Jeffrey, is a student at St. Peter’s Central Catholic Elementary School in Worcester. Holy Name will most likely be in his future as well.

At the end of the interview to compose this article, Dr. Audette finished by stating, “If we all wake up every day and listen to God, we will be in a good place. We will be successful.”

# 2011 Hall of Fame



**DR. KAREN CAMMUSO**

Karen Cammuso was a member of Holy Name's class of 1977. During her four years, she was co-editor of the yearbook, J.V. cheerleader, participated in the school musical and senior class play, and was a member of the National Honor Society and National Merit Society.

Upon graduating, Karen attended Boston College and earned her B.S. in Biology and Psychology. She then attended Catholic University of America to earn her M.A. and Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology. An internship at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Maryland as well as a fellowship at Georgetown University Hospital in Washington, DC followed.

Over the years, Karen has been appointed to various committees. Among them were Project Coordinator for Marriage and Family Studies Group, Psychologist at Accotink Academy and Assistant Clinical Director at Bradley School to name just a few. She is also the author of a number of articles which appeared in peer-reviewed journals. Karen has also been a presenter on the subject of Asperger's Disorder and also Raising Children with Character.

Currently, Karen is the Clinical Assistant Professor at Brown University's Program in Medicine.



**DANIEL PERRY**

As a member of the class of 1981, Daniel Perry was active in a variety of activities ranging from Student Government Day Representative, to photographer for the yearbook, to football player to member of the ski club.

After receiving his JD in 1990, Dan worked in private practice doing general civil and criminal litigation work. He also handled appeals before the Maine Supreme Judicial Court and the U.S. Court of Appeals for the First Circuit.

In 1999 Dan became a federal prosecutor and primarily prosecuted health care fraud cases. Two years later he transferred back to the District of Maine as a drug prosecutor. Since 2005 he has been the lead task force attorney for the District's Organized Crime and Drug Enforcement Task Force. Notable cases that Dan successfully prosecuted involved the Maine leader of the Hell's Angels Motorcycle Club and the illegal distribution of methamphetamine. Another involved a marijuana smuggling operation led by a former Montreal policeman.

Dan now serves as an Assistant U.S. Attorney and is an adjunct professor at the University of Maine School of Law.



**JAMES WALSH**

A graduate of the class of 1979, James Walsh enjoyed soccer and track but he truly loved basketball. He has fond memories of winning 10 of the last 11 games in 1978 that led the team to the district playoffs. In a game against 1st place Fitchburg, he vividly recalls making the winning basket at the buzzer!

In 1979 James was captain of Holy Name's basketball team. He clearly remembers the many hard fought games against some tough schools winning the Central Mass. Conference and the T & G Division I ratings title.

Jim was also goalie and co-captain on Holy Name's 1979 soccer team which shut out undefeated and #1 ranked North High School.

Among the sports awards Jim received was being named to Div. I Honor Team All-Stars and receiving the Ronald A. Therein Award for soccer. He was also named to the Division I Honor Team All-Star in 1978 and in 1979 he was named to the Div. I Super Team All-Star Team. Perhaps his proudest high school moment was being named Holy Name's Top Athlete.

Jim's father is the legendary Holy Name coach who was inducted into Holy Name's Hall of Fame in 2003.

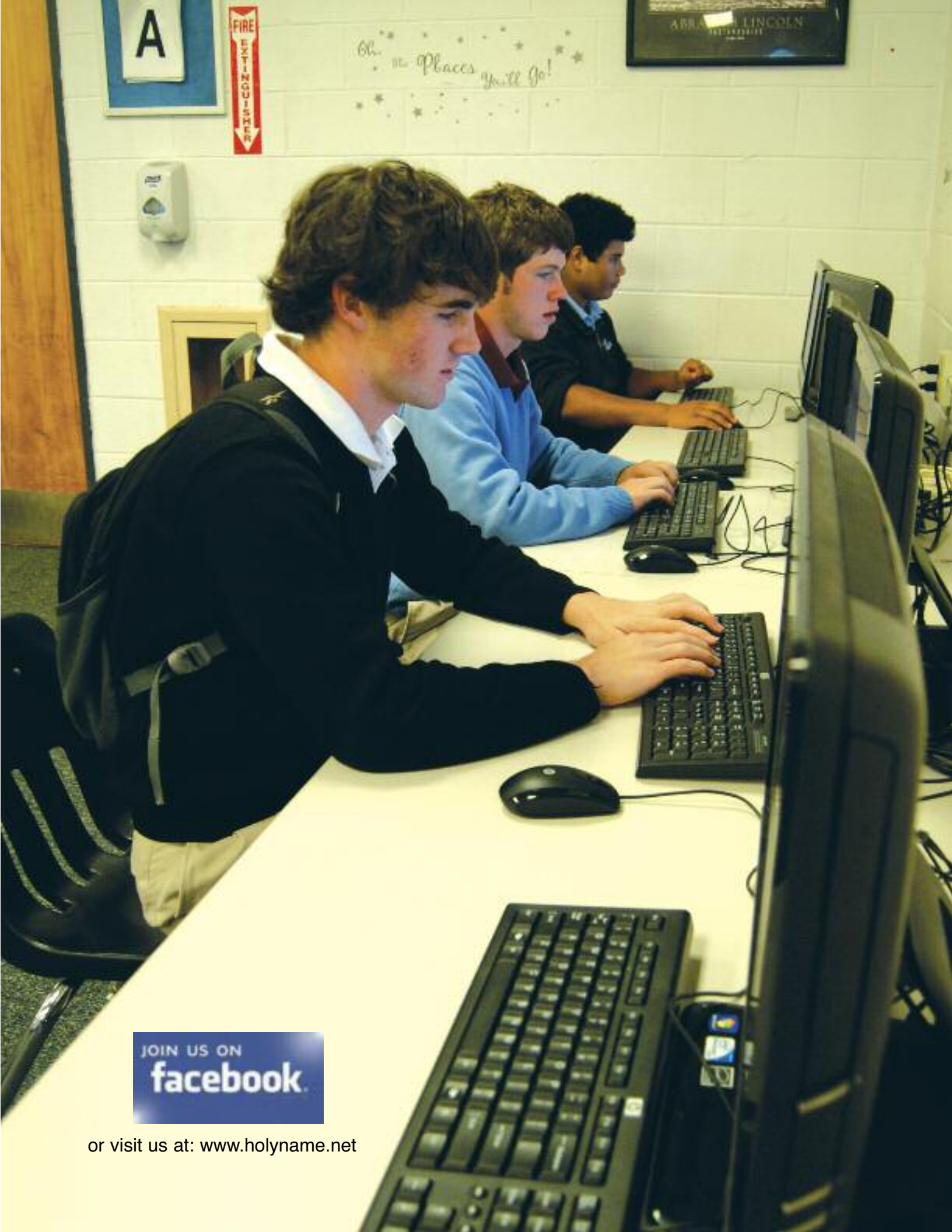
